Responsibilities:

- Editing videos from start to finish.
- Create rough and final cuts.
- Ensure proper grammar throughout videos as needed.
- Uploading finished videos to YouTube channel.

Requirements:

- A servant's heart for the Lord
- High school diploma or equivalent (minimum)
- Associate's or Bachelor's degree in relevant field (or in process) *preferred*.
- Proven work experience and/or portfolio for video editing and production.
- Proficient in any or all of the following: Adobe Premiere Pro, After Effects, FCPX, or Photoshop.
- Experience with long (music videos, event recaps, etc) and short-form content (TikTok, YouTube Shorts, etc).
- Ability to edit music and dialogue.
- SFX & VFX skills are a PLUS.
- Able to pass a background check
